## Membership Renewal for year 2021-2022

Registered Membership. Please note that the subscription this year is £52.50. The subscription being collected now will cover the following: the BBKA & KBKA subscription from date of receipt, BDI from January to December 2022.: and the BeeCraft subscription from February 2022 to January 2023 (Your present subscription runs until January 2022). New members benefits will start as above.

Bee Disease Insurance Please ensure that you take out sufficient insurance for the total number of colonies you are likely to have during the year (add the premium and total number of colonies insured in the BDI column).

**BeeCraft.** Members may choose to receive Beecraft electronically. Those doing so may reduce their subscription by £5.25 (see BeeCraft note on the bottom of page 1).

Friend + BBKA Insurance. Please note that this category of membership is offered specifically for Partners of Registered Members living at the same address.

**Friend Membership** is for those who will not own any bee colonies during the year, or those who are members of another Beekeeping Association (i.e. Surrey Beekeepers). Friends who take up beekeeping during the year will need to upgrade their membership to Registered Member.

All Members are billed to pay the sum of £2.00 towards the cost of running the Branch Apiarv.

**Tax Pavers.** If you are a tax paver please sign the Gift Aid Declaration. The tax reclaimed by KBKA helps fund County activities and keep the annual subscription down.
